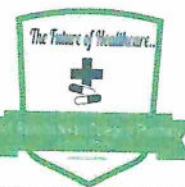

➤ Sessional Exams

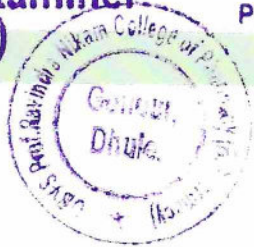
